STATEMENT

27 August 1944

On 24 August 1944 we covered ship #46 after leaving target area. I saw it crash and explode, bursting into flame. It crashed at approximatelt 43°54'N - 12°45'E. Gunners reported seeing eight or nine chutes.

26 August 1944

On the 24 of August while giving cover to ship number 46, after leaving the target area, I saw number 46 crash and burn at 43°54'N - 12°45'E at 1215. Gunners reported eight or nine chutes. Just before the plane crashed there was light flak.

27 August 1944

While returning from a mission on the 24 August 1944, we covered ship #46, it turned into enemy territory and ran into light flak. I seen 8 or 9 chutes and then the plane crashed on the ground and burned.
