In Lieu of subs a flat per diem of seven dollars (\$7.00) is atzd for travel and for periods of temp dy enroute to final destination, when necessary for officers, in accordance with existing law and regulations. Pmt of mileage is not atzd. Such times as the individual is billeted and subsisted, as outlined in WD Memo W35-2-42, 30 Sep 1942, his per diem will be susp.

A flat per diem of seven dollars (\$7.00) is atzd for EM for travel and for periods of temp dy enroute to final destination in accordance with existing law and regulations, if travel is performed by air. For travel by rail and for periods of delay enroute to final destination, monetary allowance, in lieu of rat and grs, is prescribed in accordance with WD Bulletin 19, 21 October 1943.

From time of departing fr the continental United States until arrival at perm overseas sta, pmt of per diem is atzd for a maximum of forty-five (45) days.
