2. Mission was to bomb O/R in Vienna. Were hit by flak over target. Radio Operator was killed and elevator and rudder control were lost. Oxygen systems went out. Sperry ball went out. Pilot ordered crew to bail out and they landed S.W. of Dobej, 44' 44'N, 18' 04'E.

3. Never in the hands of the enemy.

4. Sources, with exception of pilot, were picked up by Chetnicks and were brought to Hqs. Ans. S of Dobej. Pilot was picked up by Pascists and was rescued by the Mohanedan Militia. He stayed with them for a day and the Chetnicks who had picked up the rest of the crew managed to get the Mohanedan Militia to release him. He then found the other sources. Sources were brought to an airfield nearby and stayed here for 35 days trying to arrange evacuation. An American Officer came to them and contacted Italy. Planes were sent over and they were evacuated, arriving in Bari 27 December 1944.
