The 461st Bombardment Group (HD), flying B 24 Liberators was activated at Gowen Field, Idaho 11 August 1943.

The Group has had as its Commanding Officers Lt. Col. Willis G. Carter, Col. Frederic E. Glantzberg, Col. Philip R. Hawes and Lt. Col. Brooks A. Lawhon.

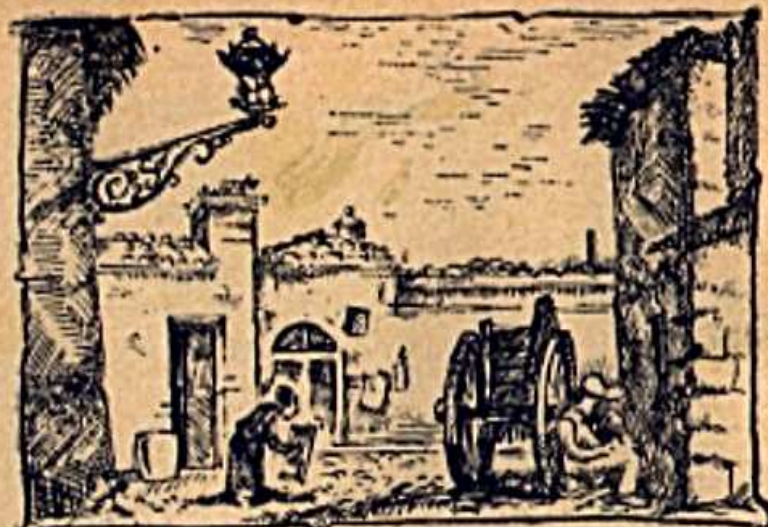
Since arriving overseas early in 1944 the 461st has twice been awarded the War Department Unit Citation for exceptionally successful bombing of the Duna Repologeppgyar Aircraft Plant at Budapest, Hungary and the Creditul - Minier Oil Refinery at Ploesti, Roumania.

The Group has completed over 146 Combat Missions and has awarded 1 Legion of Merit, 8 Silver Stars, 150 Distinguished Flying Crosses, 1850 Air Medals and 200 Purple Hearts.

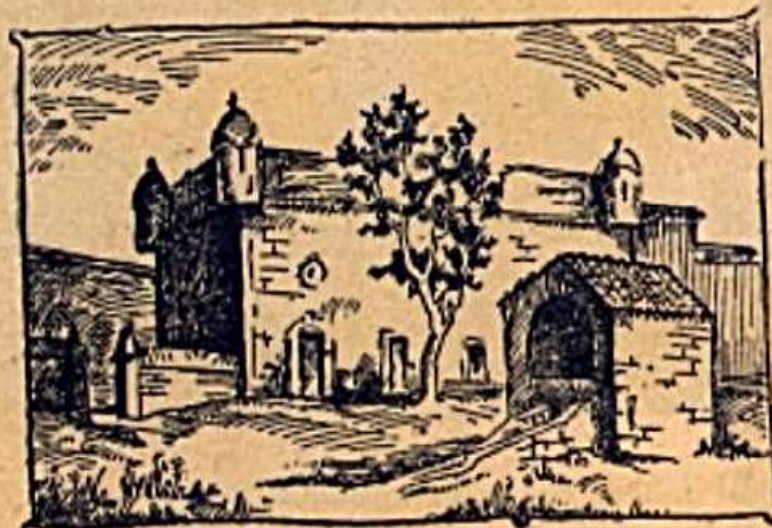




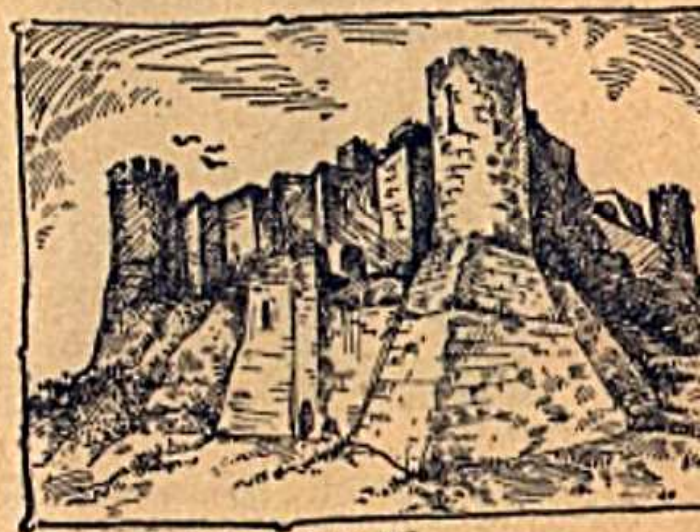
